The parties agree as follows:

1. **The Project:** The client is commissioning a colour acrylic pet portrait created by the Artist from a digital photograph/s of the pet provided by the client via email. Subject matter is [NAME OF PET] and will be painted on [DETAILS OF SIZE AND TYPE OF CANVAS]
2. **Consent:** The client consents to Cheryl Pet Portraits collecting and processing their personal data for the purpose of supplying the pet portrait and receiving newsletters and marketing materials. The client can withdraw their consent at any time by contacting [Cheryl@cherylpetportraits.co.uk](mailto:Cheryl@cherylpetportraits.co.uk). To request access, modification, or deletion of their data.
3. **Cancellation of the contract by the client:** Due to the nature of the pet portrait being a custom-made, bespoke product, cancellation of your order is only possible prior to the commencement of the portrait. Once the process of creating your bespoke pet-portrait has begun, cancellation for refund is not possible. Cancellation can be made within 48 hours of payment.
4. **Cancellation of the contract by the artist:** if the artist cannot complete the contract and has no alternative but to cancel, any monies paid to the artist by the client are returnable.
5. **Copyright:** The artist retains all copyright of the produced artwork. Ultimately this means that the customer has permission to share the work publicly and use it on display for private use but any reproduction of the work, especially reproductions that will be used for profit or commercial uses, is strictly prohibited unless approved by the artist in writing. Failing to do so is a crime and may result in legal action.



6. **Payment amount:** Prices for specific canvas sizes are outlined on the Artist's website. This contract confirms the agreed price that is due from the client for the pet portrait.
7. **Payment terms and procedure:** To ensure commencement of your pet portrait, upfront payment is required. This advance enables necessary resources to be secured and dedicated time allocated. Please refer to invoice over the page for payment details.
